THE 17th BRUNEL RUN 3/4/5 September 2010 GENERAL INFORMATION

On behalf of Bristol Area MG Owners Club please find enclosed a booking form for The Brunel Run 2010. Last year's fundraising resulted in a generous donation for The Bristol Childrens' Help Society - a big thank you to all who made this possible. All of our fundraising at the Brunel Run weekend event will be donated to them again.

We will be resident at Barton Camp near Winscombe, Somerset. The facilities there are fantastic, with camping facilities plus some indoor accommodation, a heated swimming pool and indoor games hall. Theo and his team will once again be cooking their five star breakfasts!

The weekend package includes 2 nights camping, two cooked 'full English' breakfasts, the Run and rally plaque, a meal on Saturday evening, Saturday evening disco and Sunday self judging. All you need to bring, apart from your tent of course, is something to eat on Friday evening, and some liquid refreshment. Last year our Fish and Chip run proved very popular on the Friday evening, and we will be arranging this again. Please note on the booking form if you will be interested in this service, so that we may forewarn the excellent local chippy.

If you are unable to make the whole weekend, we will be pleased to accept entries for the Saturday only. The entry fee of £20 per car will include The Brunel Run, a rally plaque, and light refreshments upon return to Barton Camp, if you would like to stay for Saturday evening, for the meal, the cost will be £10 per head. Should you be entering for the run only but would like a cooked breakfast this can be ordered in advance for only £5.50 per head.

Please note that the limited indoor accommodation will be reserved only upon receipt of a completed booking form, disclaimer and cheque. If you are prepared to share a small dormitory with friends, that would be most helpful, and would 'stretch' the indoor availability.

Friday 3rd September: The site is open from 2.30pm please do not arrive before this time.

Saturday 4th September: Breakfast will be served from 7.30am - 9am in the restaurant. The Brunel Run will start from 9.15, with a scenic mystery drive. Returning to Barton Camp tea and biccies will be served. Later on Saturday evening, after your chance to watch the sun set over the Somerset countryside, we will sit down for our meal.

Sunday 5th September: Breakfast will be served from 8.00am until 9.30am, followed by self judging, presentations and the bumper raffle.
