<b>EVENT CO-ORDINATOR'S REPORT</b>	
<p><b>Club Venue</b></p> <p>The committee discussed the pros and cons of the Poacher and the RFC Concern was raised regarding access to the pub garden during the summer, that other people would access it through the dining room where we hold our meetings, the noise on the roof in the rain. Plus side was that it may be a more secure venue and that no costs were involved.</p> <p>The RFC would not charge for the venue if the takings were over £150, which they were in November otherwise £20 per hour would be paid, currently the provisional arrangement was for 8.00pm - 10.00pm. Plus was the sole use of the venue, and in the summer there is a downstairs room to access the outside, plenty of parking. We used their projector which proved successful in November. In the summer there would be no draught beer as the club is less used then, an issue the committee felt was not a deal breaker.</p> <p>Following a vote, the committee all agreed to go forward with the RFC, and asked that VD shared all contact details with the committee especially the Area Secretaries. We asked that VD make the arrangement permanent as she had been dealing with them in the first place.</p> <p>RD reported that Pete Cannard's run was very successful with lots of positive comments, he would arrange another in due course.</p> <p>Cobweb run to be held on 14 January, website will have joining details.
