<p><b>EVENT CO-ORDINATOR'S REPORT</b></p>	
<p>VD and RD thanked BH for the Colin Wotley run.  Advised the next week day lunch meet was at the Poplars on 3 December.  Christmas club night buffet will be £7.50 per head.  January club night VD and RD will host a 'what is it' quiz  Cobweb Run on 16 January - 11 cars booked in so far  Not the Bluebell Run - 5 cars booked so far  Possible tour of Haynes Museum and restoration workshops cost £12.50 per head - date to be arranged  VD mentioned a possible weekend based in Barnstable or at the RNLI at Poole  Volunteers required for Sunday runs  It was discussed to publicise ideas for events to members</p>	
<p><b>ANNUAL CLUB EVENT (Brunel) Date 09/10/11 September</b></p>	
<p>The committee held a wide ranging discussion on the possibility of running this event in 2022, highlights are:  PB advised figures and costs which would lead to making this a viable financial event.  Run only £30 per car, weekend with accommodation £75 per person to include 2 breakfasts and Saturday evening meal, we would not 'bring in' entertainment but would have background music supplied by AH.  If we had 30 weekenders and 20 run only we would raise £1300 before costs  IS advised that over the years BAMGOC had given Barton Camp £19800 with gift aid £24750, not including the monies raised by PL for masks etc which stands at £2500 plus gift aid at 20%.  PL will sort her spreadsheets from the last Brunel event and distribute to the committee for comment.
