



LOCK-DOWN TRIP#1 2021- only 8 miles but full of questions!

THIS IS LIKE A TABLE-TOP RALLY BUT USING GOOGLE MAPS INSTEAD OF THE ORDNANCE SURVEY.

There is no prize and don't worry about sending in the answers. They will be published somewhere eventually!

TO OPEN STREET VIEW or SATELLITE VIEW ON GOOGLE MAPS:

ON A LAPTOP: Find the little orange man  (bottom right on a laptop) and click on him to drag him to the road you want to follow (accessible roads will light up in blue. Exit Street View using the arrow at top left of the picture. To change from Map View to Satellite View click on the square icon at the bottom of the map which will be labelled Map or Satellite.

ON A TABLET: Tap on the layers icon at the top right of the screen  and a menu will open where you can select Satellite View and Street View. Satellite View shows an aerial shot of the scene and Street View highlights accessible roads in blue. Double tapping on the required blue road takes you into Street View.

There are 15 questions. **SO..... LET'S GO!!!** (emergency map at the end)

Step 1.	On Google Maps search for: The White Hart, The Street, Olveston, Bristol BS35 4DP	
Step 2.	IN STREET VIEW, THE WHITE HART SHOULD BE ON YOUR LEFT HAND SIDE with the church ahead of you.	
Step 3.	Q1. What is the name of the church?	
Step 4.	Continue along The Street and carefully pass the Waitrose truck. TURN RIGHT into ELBERTON ROAD	
Step 5.	Q2. What's the name of the school on your right?	
Step 6.	After almost a mile, the road swings right.	
Step 7.	Q3. How many people and dogs are socially distancing on your right? (this picture captured August 2020)	
Step 8.	At the T-junction, TURN RIGHT towards Thornbury/Alveston (B4461) After about 0.4 miles there is a seemingly pointless traffic island.	
Step 9.	Q4. What is the phone number of Elberton Garage?	
Step 10.	Continue along B4461 (which becomes Vattingstone Lane) to Alveston (about another 1.5 miles) to STOP SIGN. TURN LEFT towards AUST.	
Step 11.	Q5. What are the opening hours of Alveston Stores on your left?	
Step 12.	At T-junction TURN LEFT (Thornbury Road/B4061)	

Step 13.	Q6. What is the name of the Premier Inn on your immediate right?	
Step 14.	Continue to Thornbury (about 0.7 miles)	
Step 15.	Q7. What service is advertised on a black Smart car opposite Thornbury Leisure Centre?	
Step 16.	Continue 0.3 miles to roundabout. TAKE FIRST EXIT	
Step 17.	Q8. What gardening feature is on your left?	
Step 18.	Q9. Who is allowed to park without limit outside the bright pink house on your left?	
Step 19.	Continue through the High Street (even though it is shown as closed).	
Step 20.	Pass The Malthouse on your right	
Step 21.	Q10. What large white animal can you see on your left? (It's not a Greek animal though!)	
Step 22.	Q11. Find a place that sells a dish made typically of flattened bread dough spread with a savoury mixture usually including tomatoes and cheese and tell me when it was supposedly built?	
Step 23.	Where the road swings right - KEEP LEFT towards Cemetery/Community Centre	
Step 24.	Q12. Immediately on your right, there's a place where you can get keys cut. Look high for the name of these premises.	
Step 25.	Pass the Churchill Retirement development on the left. TAKE NEXT LEFT into Kington Lane.	
Step 26.	Q13. How many children are with the two women on the left near the cemetery?	
Step 27.	After about 2.5 miles enter Oldbury on Severn There is a church on a small tump on the left.	
Step 28.	Q14. What is the name of this church?	
Step 29.	Continue for about half a mile along Church Hill to THE ANCHOR INN on your right.	
Step 30.	There is an inviting beer garden here so maybe that's far enough for today. You'll have to use your imagination here to enjoy a good meal in good company.	
Step 31.	Q15. One last question: How many people can you see in the car park?	
Step 32.	WELL DONE AT REACHING THE END OF THIS TRIP!
